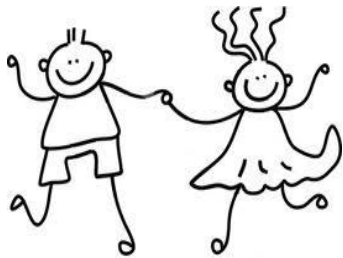

- Plan where you will go if an emergency happens
- Plan driving routes and alternates
